Justification

Project Based Learning is a teaching method in which students gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period of time to investigate and respond to an authentic, engaging and complex question, problem, or challenge. Project work is not a new methodology. Its benefits have been widely recognized for many years.

- Learn to survey your unit and choose material for a project.
- Examine how concepts and driving questions help in project creation.
- Learn how to teach LOTS and HOTS through projects.
- Learn how to include CALP and BICS in projects.
- Examine the techniques of AFL- Assessment for Learning and how they work with projects: Idea Generation, Success Criteria, Drafting, Feedback, Critique.
- Discover how to help students build self-efficacy through projects.
- Analyze how to use Social Entrepreneurship projects to advance students' academic knowledge and develop soft skills.
