


READING CLUB

Navarra – Nafarroa

Type: Seminar.

Addressed to: 25 Teachers of English as a foreign language. Teachers teaching in English can apply too.

Important Note: We don't have information about whether you teach a subject in English or not, or whether you are in a bilingual program or not. So, please, tell us what subject and in what language you teach it, and what language program you are in (PAI, British, bilingual..) on the "Notas o comentarios/Oharrak eta iradokizunak" section when you register for this course, otherwise we can not assure admission.



Justification: Besides being a pleasure, reading books in English contributes not only to the development of communicative competence but also to the reading competence in that language. In this seminar different types of books will be read and analyzed.

Aims

- To get the chance to improve communicative competence through reading .
- To get to know specific vocabulary
- To share experiences and views on three books or novels.

Contents

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- Individual reading of three books.
- Sharing and debating the three books bearing in mind the following criteria:
 - Their literary values regarding style, language and structure
 - Their topics, ethics and points of social interest
 - The way they can be used for didactic purposes

Methodology: During this seminar, three books will be read and debated.

On the first day participants will have the chance to talk about their interests regarding books and three books from a list will be chosen (please note that the CAP/ILZ cannot provide them). The methodology will be explained in the first session.

On each of the following days a selected book will be debated. Before the meeting participants will have to read the book and send a worksheet by email answering some questions on it.

The main aim is to share different views and opinions on the books. The teacher will try to encourage a debate in which didactic purposes will also appear.

- 1- Belonging to the category of teachers the seminar is addressed to.
- 2- Order of inscription

Notes

- From now on all the notifications related with training courses will be sent to the official PNTE email account assigned to each teacher in the Public Education System (usuario@educacion.navarra.es). Teachers in private and semi-private schools will receive them in the email account they have stated in EDUCA.

- The list of accepted teachers will be published, at the shortest time possible once the signing up period is over, on the following address:

- When a teacher that has been accepted cannot attend an activity, he/she must inform the person in charge of that activity (this information is in the “convocatoria/deialdia”) before the beginning of the activity so he/she can be unregistered. Not doing so will start a process that will penalize this person with 5 months of banning from the registering platform, which means this person will not be allowed to register for any training activity organized by the Education Department in Navarra. This penalty does not excuse teachers from the 35 compulsory training hours all teachers must take each school year.
- Only teachers that are actively working can take part and get the certification, with the exception of those in leave of absence for maternity, adoption, and fostering, according to the D.F. 71/2017 from August 23rd. Any situation of temporary incapacity is incompatible with the assistance to training activities.
- In order to obtain the certificate, teachers must attend to at least 85% of the face-to-face sessions, and sign the signature sheet each and every session with permanent ink pen (not erasable). If there is no signature, then attendance will not count, that is, we will not accept any kind of justification. In those activities which homework is included in the total hours, presenting the paper/s will be compulsory to get the certification.
